Teamsters at Black Ball Ferry Line proudly load and unload passengers and freight onto the MV COHO ship, serving the run from the beautiful harbour of Victoria, British Columbia, to the friendly town of Port Angeles, Washington, USA.

Since 1818, ships have proudly flown the Black Ball flag – displayed as a black "ball" on a red background. In 2013, the MV COHO was recognized by the Steam Ship Historical Society of America as the Ship of the Year and received the 2012 SS Beaver Medal, from the Maritime Society of British Columbia.
