## Scholarship Information for the 2024-2025 Academic Year

It is time once again to think about scholarships offered to your eligible child or grandchild through your Local Union No. 31 and the International Brotherhood of Teamsters.

Information and application forms are available for:

- **James R. Hoffa Memorial Scholarship (JRHMS)** for the son, daughter, or financial dependent of a Teamster Member or qualified retiree who is a member “in good standing”; in their last year of high school and planning to attend an accredited four-year college or university. **Deadline March 1, 2024.** (\$10,000 and \$1000). **Applications must be submitted online only at [www.jrhmsf.org](http://www.jrhmsf.org).**
- **James R. Hoffa Memorial Scholarship (JRHMS) 2024 Training and Vocational Programs Scholarship** for the son, daughter, or financial dependent of a Teamster member (including BLET, BMWED and GCC members). The training and vocational programs must be related to work in a Teamster-represented industry, class or craft. **Deadline March 1, 2024.** Scholarship winners are awarded training and vocational scholarships up to \$2000 depending on financial need. **Applications must be submitted online only at [www.jrhmsf.org](http://www.jrhmsf.org).**
- **Teamsters Scholarship Fund** this scholarship will provide six hundred (600) two-thousand dollar (\$2,000.00) scholarships to graduating seniors of the Class of 2024. These awards are merit-based. To qualify, applicants must be a son, daughter or dependent of a Teamster member in good standing. **Deadline March 29, 2024. Applications must be submitted online only at [Teamster.org/scholarships](http://Teamster.org/scholarships).**
- **International Brotherhood of Teamsters Women’s Caucus Scholarship** for daughters or sons of an active or retired Teamster member with 12 months of consecutive status; graduating from high school in 2024. Application attached. **Deadline May 1, 2024.** (2 x \$500)
- **Teamsters Local Union No. 31 Scholarship** for the eligible children/grandchildren of active members, graduating from high school in 2024. Application attached. **Deadline March 1, 2024.** (10 x \$2500)
- **Art Price Memorial Scholarship** for children/grandchildren of members in good standing of Local Union No. 31. Applicants should be enrolled in grade 12 or in a post-secondary institution (college/university/trade school), 23 years or younger. Application attached. **Deadline March 1, 2024.** (1 x \$2500)

## **INTERNATIONAL TEAMSTER WOMEN'S CAUCUS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

### **Application Criteria**

**The International Teamster Women's Caucus (ITWC) awards two (2) scholarships annually not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) each to deserving high school seniors. All applications must comply with the following eligibility and application criteria. Each applicant must:**

- 1. Be the daughter or son of an active or retired Teamster member (parent/guardian) who has at least twelve months of consecutive membership in good standing in the Teamsters Union as of the date of application;**
- 2. Be in the last year of high school or GED program and may not apply if already graduated from high school;**
- 3. Plan to submit SAT or ACT scores for academic evaluation, if applicable;**
- 4. Plan to submit financial information for financial evaluation, if applicable;**
- 5. Plan to attend an accredited college, university, trade or business school.**

### **Application Procedure**

- 1. Complete this application. Forward the application to the International Teamster Women's Caucus by May 1st of your graduation year in order to be received by the necessary deadline.**
- 2. Along with your completed application, additional information will be required. This information is as follows:**
  - a) An official high school transcript which includes your class rank.**
  - b) GED Certificate and applicable records or;**
  - c) SAT results or ACT results for academic consideration, where applicable.**
  - d) Financial Statements for financial aid consideration, where applicable.**
  - e) Proof of Teamster parent/guardian membership status (copy of latest dues receipt or print out)**

- A current transcript of grades and a résumé, to be sent complete with a cover letter, two letters of reference and an application form are required. Do not send a photo with your application.

## LOCAL 31 ART PRICE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

It is awarded annually in the amount of \$2500. Applicants should currently be enrolled in grade 12 or in a post-secondary institution— (college/university/trade school), 23 years old or younger.

The fund was created in 2007 to honour Brother Art “Buttons” Price who was a member of Local 31 from August of 1960, until his passing on April 22, 1993. In his long Teamster career, Brother Price served as Chairman for the shop stewards; he was a committee member on several sets of freight negotiations; and also held the positions of Business Representative and Secretary-Treasurer. He was always available and ready to serve others at any time, no matter whether friend or member.
